The government launched the National Technical Textiles Mission (NTTM) in 2020, for which a budget of ₹1,480 crore has been allocated.

DRDO and the Indian Navy successfully tested the VL-SRSAM missile in Chandipur, Odisha, which is capable of destroying high-speed aerial targets. The US Senate confirmed the appointment of Dr. Jai Bhattacharya as the director of the National Institutes of Health (NIH). He was nominated by Donald Trump. He remained in controversies due to his opposition to lockdown and mask mandates during the COVID-19 pandemic.

The Reserve Bank of India has approved the increase in ATM interchange charges from 1 May 2025. This increase has been made on the request of white label ATM operators, which may have a greater impact on small bank customers.





The center-state share is 90:10 in hilly and northeastern states, 60:40 in other states and the entire premium will be borne by the Center in Union Territories.
